

Document Overview

The purpose of this document is to provide information on how to use PearsonAccess^{next} to successfully create online test sessions for students or move students in existing test sessions to different sessions. Users can export student test data, update the file with session information, and import the updated file to add/move corresponding tests into online test sessions.

Note: An Assessment Coordinator, or other designated individual with the appropriate PearsonAccess^{next} user roles, are able to access the Session Create/Move Import and Export files.

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Directions for Exporting Student Session Information

How to Export Students through the Session Create/Move

Note: Moving a student test from one session to another can only occur within the same testing organization (i.e., school). Student demographic and accommodation data cannot be updated during this Create/Move process; use the Student Registration Export/Import process for this purpose.

This section provides information on how to use PearsonAccess^{next} to successfully create or update online test sessions for students who are registered to test. District Assessment Coordinators (DACs) and School Assessment Coordinators (SACs) can export student test data, update the file with session information, and import the updated file to add/move student tests into sessions.

Step	Directions
1. Create a Session Export File	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choose the administration year from the dropdown in the main menu of PearsonAccess^{next}.
2. Export Session Create/Move File	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Go to Setup > Import/Export Data. ● Select Import/Export Data under the Tasks dropdown and click Start. ● Under Type, select Session Create/Move Export. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Grade Level When Assessed and/or Subject parameters are available to include specific results in the file export. ○ Check the “Include Completed and Marked Complete Tests” box to include completed tests in the file export. ● Click Process.
3. View File Details	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Go to the View File Details tab for file processing information. ● When the file is indicated as Complete, select Download File.



Directions for Updating & Importing Student Session Information

How to Update and Import the Session Create/Move File

Step	Directions
<p>1. Update Student Session Information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Update the exported file with session changes in Column K. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Adding a Session Name into a blank field in Column K creates a session and places the student into the new session. ○ Changing the name of a session from the current <i>existing</i> session to another session moves the student into the other session when imported. ● Save the updated file as a .CSV file. <p>Notes: Each time a file is imported, the corresponding student tests are added/moved to the specified session for that organization. If the Session Name listed on the import file does not already exist for the corresponding school, it is created. For the session details, Start Date defaults to the date the session was created and the Form Group Type defaults to Main (through the user interface, update the Form Group Type after the session is created if the students in the session require an Auditory/Signed Presentation Script). Students are not removed from sessions when the session field is left blank on import.</p>
<p>2. Import Session Create/Move File</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Choose the administration from the dropdown in the top banner of PearsonAccess^{next}. ● Go to Setup > Import/Export Data. ● Select Import/Export Data under the Tasks dropdown and click Start. ● Under Type, select Session Create/Move Import. ● Click Choose File and select the locally saved Session Create/Move file. ● Click Process. ● When the import is completed, the student is added to the appropriate online test session.
